The Sunshine Coast Soccer Supa Oldies Association Incorporated (SCSOS) is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, well-organised, and enjoyable football environment for men aged 35 years and over and women aged 30 years and over.

Our primary focus is participation, enjoyment, fitness, friendship, and good sportsmanship rather than winning. We welcome players of all abilities and backgrounds and strive to foster a supportive community where everyone has the opportunity to enjoy the game in a respectful and positive environment.

The Association conducts mid-week Six-a-Side competitions, which have been running successfully since 1994. The continued success of these competitions relies on all participants respecting the rules, officials, fellow players, and the spirit of the game. Competition formats, divisions, and season structures may be adjusted by the Committee to best meet the needs of the Association and its members.

Culture and Values

The SCSOS is built on the values of:

Respect – Treat all players, referees, volunteers, spectators, and officials with courtesy and respect at all times.

Inclusion – Welcome and value people of all backgrounds, cultures, abilities, genders, and experiences.

Participation – Encourage enjoyment, fitness, teamwork, and lifelong involvement in football above competition and results.

Sportsmanship – Play fairly, accept decisions graciously, and demonstrate integrity both on and off the field.

Safety – Promote a safe playing environment where the wellbeing of every participant is the highest priority.

Community – Foster friendships, camaraderie, and a strong sense of belonging within our Association.

SCSOS has zero tolerance for discrimination, harassment, bullying, or vilification of any kind. Every participant has the right to enjoy football free from sexual harassment, racial discrimination, or discrimination based on gender, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation, or any other protected characteristic. Any behaviour that demeans, intimidates, or excludes another person is inconsistent with our values and may result in disciplinary action.

As an over-35s social competition, players are expected to compete hard but fairly. Deliberate, reckless, or dangerous play that is intended to injure, intimidate, or physically harm another player has no place in our Association. All participants are expected to exercise reasonable care for the safety of others, play within both the Laws of the Game and the spirit of fair play, and remember that everyone is here to enjoy football in a safe and respectful environment.
